1. INTERNATIONAL SCOPE

Following the preparatory committee of the Tenth Rover Forum, we believe that the matter of the organisation's international scope has been unacknowledged or at least very rarely touched upon by the Rovers/Compañeros of ASDE Scouts de España.

Consequently, we feel a discussion panel is necessary to address this matter, and to serve as a means of communication and to promote among different countries the programmes on offer.

The international scope panel will be held at the same time as the First Euro-Mediterranean Forum and intends to improve practices among countries and create agreements between the different Scouts Associations of the respective countries. For this reason, the participants will have to be able to express themselves fluently in English.

b. Adaptation and treatment of foreign cultures in international programmes

The discrepancies between the different cultures which make up the WOSM (World Organization Scout Movement) are numerous. For this reason, during the Tenth Rover Forum, and also the First Euro-Mediterranean Forum, we will carry out a thorough analysis of the cultures which make up the international scout community, we will conduct a discussion about different situations in the area of international programmes, and we will propose forms of action in each of these instances.

2. SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENTS

Following the work carried out in teams, we will meet to present the different proposals and accept them during the panel so that, afterwards, we can draw up a document with the conclusions.

When we have covered all of the above points, we will compose a document to present during the Assembly, which will be being carried out at the same time as the Tenth Rover Forum.
